

Cookies Policy

INTRODUCTION

Agreegain Limited (“we” or “us” or “our”) uses cookies to facilitate and improve your experience of our website and to provide and improve our products and services.

COOKIES

Cookies are small files containing a string of characters with a unique identifier, that are placed on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. Your browser then provides that unique identifier to use each time you submit a query to the site. Cookies are created by websites and are commonly used to enhance the browsing experience, provide personalized content, and gather information about user behavior.

You can configure your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, some website features or services may not function properly without cookies.

OUR COOKIES

- First Party Cookies are cookies that belong to us and can be either permanent or temporary. These are necessary cookies, without which the site won't work properly or be able to provide certain features and functionalities. Some of these may be manually disabled in your browser, but may affect the functionality of the site.
- Third Party Cookies are cookies that another party places on your computer/device through our website. We use third party providers such as Google Analytics to collect information about the usage of our services and enable us to improve how these services work, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

Storage duration

- Session cookies are temporary and expire at the end of your browser session.
- Persistent cookies remain on your hard drive until you erase them or your browser does, depending on the cookie's expiration date. These allow us to remember your preferences so you may access web pages faster and with better convenience..

Our uses of cookies, fall into the following general categories:

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are necessary to allow us to operate our site so you may access them as you have requested. These Cookies make a website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. They also include Cookies that

enable us to remember your previous actions within the same browsing session and secure our website.

Statistics/Analytics

Also known as “performance cookies,” these cookies collect information about how you use a website, like which pages you visited and which links you clicked on. None of this information can be used to identify you since it is being collected anonymously. It is all aggregated and, therefore, anonymized. Their sole purpose is to improve website functions. This includes cookies from third-party analytics services as long as the cookies are for the exclusive use of the owner of the website visited.

Marketing Cookies

Marketing cookies track visitors across websites. They help advertisers deliver more relevant advertising or limit the number of times you see an ad.

Unclassified Cookies

Unclassified cookies are cookies that we are in the process of classifying, together with the providers of individual cookies.

CONTROL OF COOKIES

Most browsers are set to accept cookies by default. However, you can remove or reject cookies in your browser’s settings. If you do not wish cookies to be stored on your computer or device, you can deactivate the relevant option in the system settings of your browser. You can also delete stored cookies in the system settings of your browser at any time.
